

REVEREND DANIEL ALBERTSON

Pastor Dan was ordained as a Presbyterian Pastor in December of 1997 and served as the Senior Minister for a church of 2,000 members. He was vital in efforts to both successfully grow the church by 500 members in three years and increase giving by more than 75%.

Pastor Dan spends much of his time ministering to the persons experiencing homelessness in Chandler through a comprehensive outreach program. The success of the program with those served has been stunning. More than 70% of the persons experiencing homelessness served through this Ministry have attained meaningful employment within one month of their program participation. Each month, more than 25% of the homeless clients served have secured decent, affordable housing.

Pastor Dan is also the Coordinator of volunteers, Outreach and Fellowship at Chandler Presbyterian Church.

Pastor Dan is a member of Rotary International Past Club Secretary, Past Club President of the San Tan Crown Rotary Club and Past Co-Chair of the Rotary International Micro-Credit Banking program which educates and mentors persons of low, or no income, in Latin America with the fundamentals necessary to succeed with their business start-ups.

This program has impacted the lives of, literally, hundreds of families in Latin America through the Micro Credit Banking program. This program makes it possible for individuals to be self-sufficient, support their families and afford the services and goods offered by a variety of vendors. Importantly, this program keeps families intact while reducing Illegal Immigration. Approximately \$100,000 is raised in the U.S.A. and Canada yearly – which is loaned to those entrepreneurs in their business start-up efforts. Impressively, 90% of the money loaned for these start-up businesses has been repaid.

Pastor Dan is an inspiration for all. He leads by example. Often, he references scripture as it might apply to specific circumstances. He is a leader who listens; who cares. Pastor Dan works collaboratively with a variety of individuals, places of worship, businesses and social care agencies to ensure all that he serves are positioned to succeed. Pastor Dan is a born nurturer. Of his many appointments, Pastor Dan was a High School Math teacher for 5 years and later held high offices in Government and the Public Sector including Micro Credit Bank President and CEO of the top-ranked Micro-Credit Bank in Sub-Saharan Africa and President of a Micro Credit Bank in Mexico.

Pastor Dan has been the chair of HR in the largest Christian Hospital in Sub Saharan Africa with over 300 employees. He has Spearheaded buying of properties, managing apartment complexes, building of Schools, Hospitals, Christian Guest houses and retreat Centers Pastor Dan has served as Pulpit Supply at different churches in the Grand Canyon Presbytery and De Cristo.
